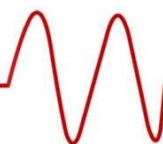


Updating your software

- 1) Go to MyMitsubishi website:

- 2) Log into MyMitsubishi or create an account.
- 3) Click on 'software' within the Downloads column

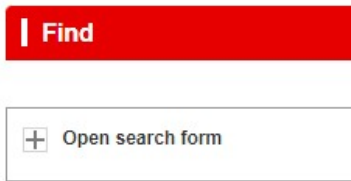

4) Click on 'open search form'



5) Type in the desired software in the 'find' field and click on the 'find' button.



6) Many search items will appear, you will need distinguish the latest version. The easiest way is by looking at the uploaded date. (US date format)

7) Click on 'blue arrow' download,

8) Once downloaded, IMPORTANT, back up any working projects on an external drive and uninstall the previous version of software, this is so the new installation does not clash with older files.

9) Mitsubishi recommends to check online updates every 6-8 months as newer hardware and software bug fixes are implemented.
